Yamhill County Mushrooms is located 3 miles north of Yamhill, OR, on 160 wooded acres. The farm originated with Bill Darm in 1985, and it was then handed down to his son, Bob Darm, several years later. Today, with help from grower Leo Pérez, the farm now produces over 5 million pounds of *Agaricus bisporus* mushrooms annually. Over half of the 70 employees have been with the company for more than 10 years. They have a complex system of composting that uses computers to track and monitor the growing conditions so that the mushrooms thrive.



### Wasp Power

The farm uses predatory wasps to control the fly population instead of chemicals.
